The Amazon River basin in Brazil has a small population, even though Brazil has a large population. It is difficult to live in the Amazon River basin because much of the land is a tropical rain forest. The rain forest receives about 50 to 120 inches (130 to 305 centimeters) of rain each year. The air is very humid, and the plant and tree growth is lush. It is difficult to keep the plants and the trees cut back in order to build on the land.

The natives of the Amazon River basin raise corn and manioc, an edible root. The manioc is pounded into flour to make breads, cakes, and soups. The native people also hunt and fish for their food. They make baskets for storing food by weaving leaves from rain forest plants. Many grow cotton, which they use to make clothing.

The houses of the people who live in the . Amazon River basin are built above the ground on wooden poles. When the Amazon River overflows its banks, the land floods but the houses stay dry. Leaves are woven together to form a roof. The roofs are slanted almost to the ground to help the rain drain quickly.






