### Easy directions allow for more learning time!

When players stumble upon a time machine, they must use their reading skills to travel through time. With the roll of the die, they make their way around the board, reading and answering leveled Story Cards that propel them from prehistoric times to the distant future.

A variety of Story Card questions ask students to find the main idea, use context clues, read for detail, find cause and effect, form contractions, find synonyms, and much more.

The first player to successfully travel the path to the distant future wins!

### Learning Well games let students focus on learning!

1. Winning is based on knowledge and skills, not random factors.
2. Games address important content, not trivia.
3. Graphics and content are high-interest and directions are easy to understand, so as not to restrict learning opportunities.
4. Players never lose points for wrong answers.
