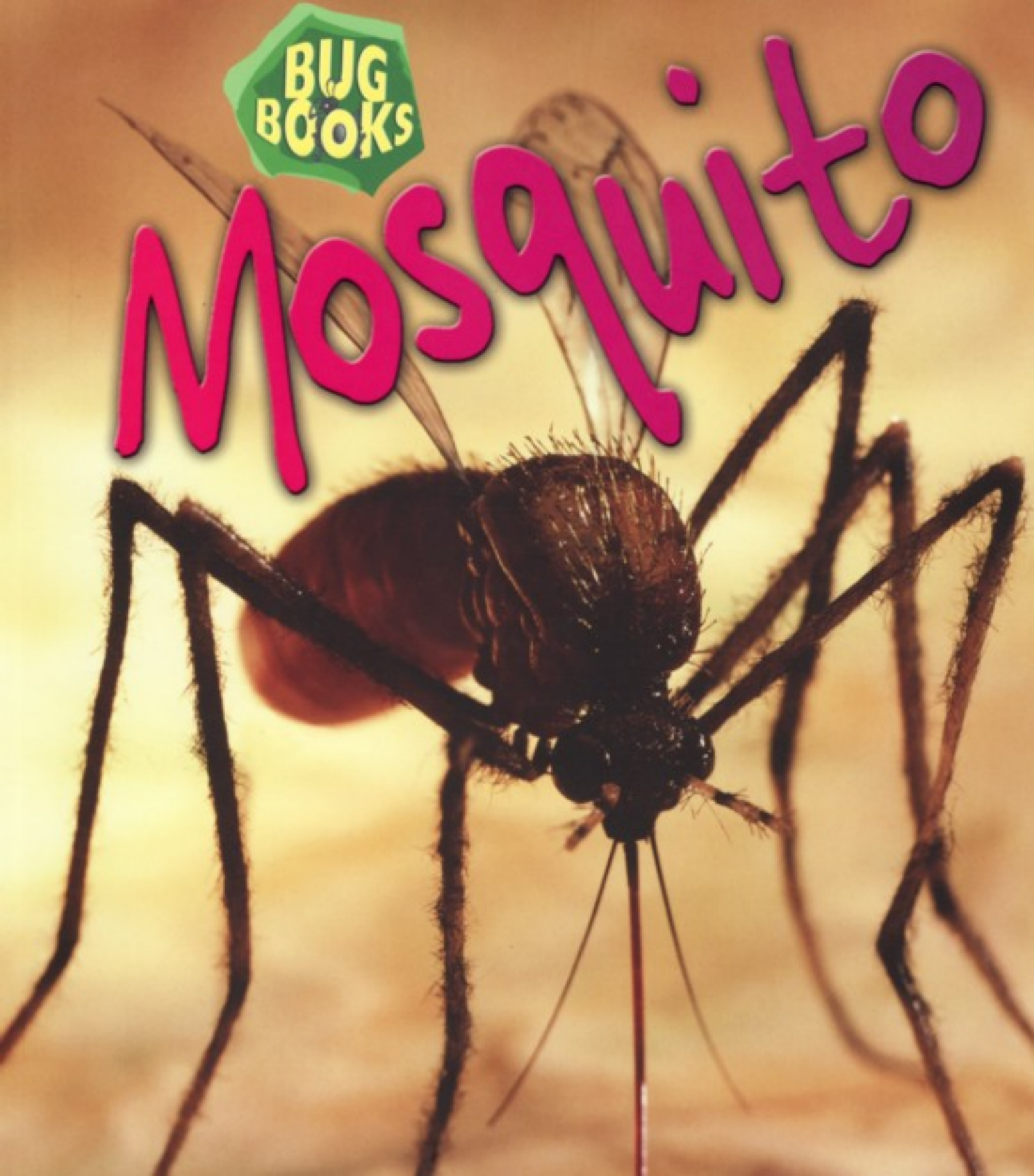

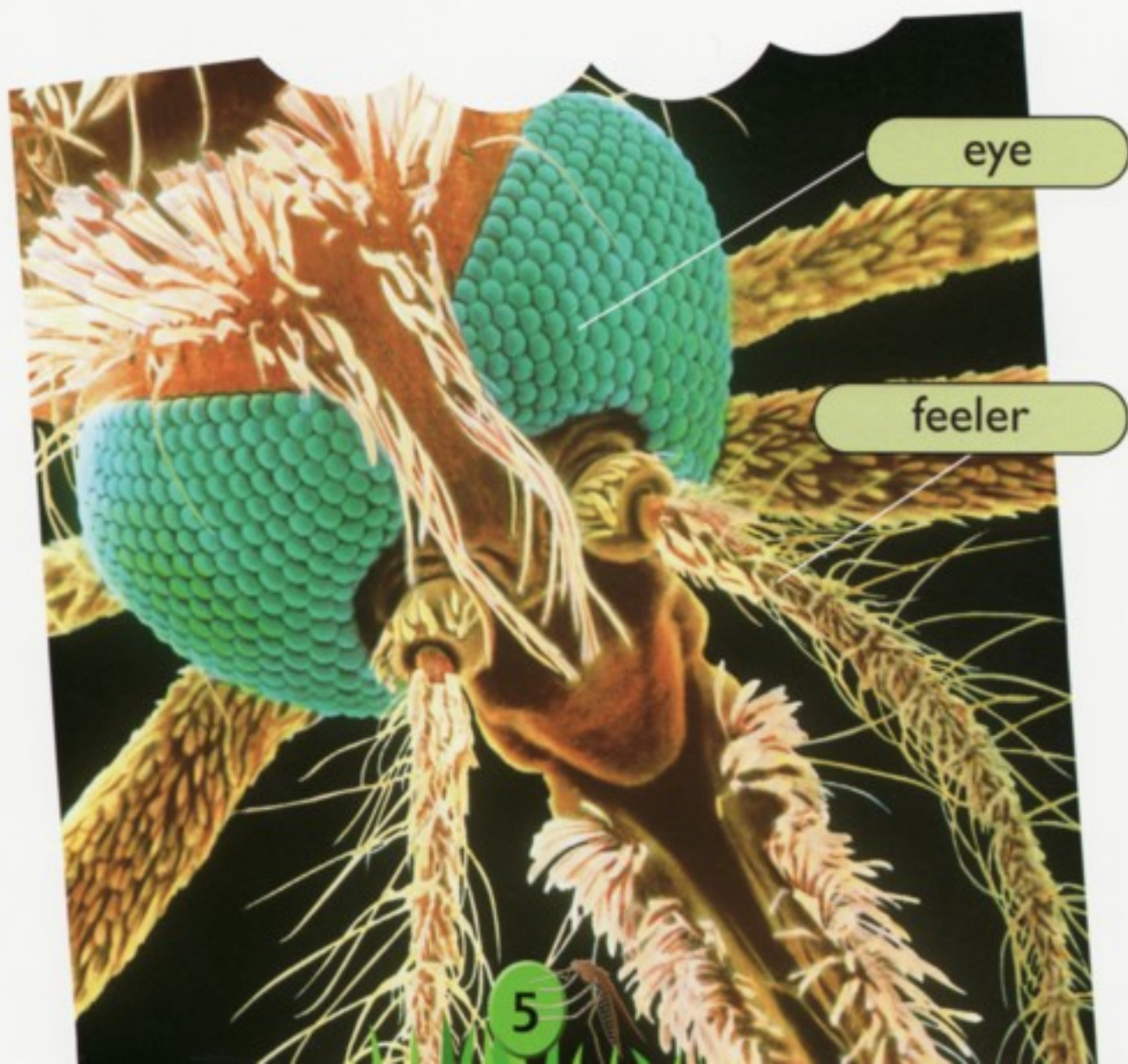
What Are Mosquitoes?
