EVENTUALLY, I TOOK LUCIA TO DANCE...



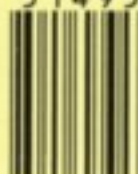

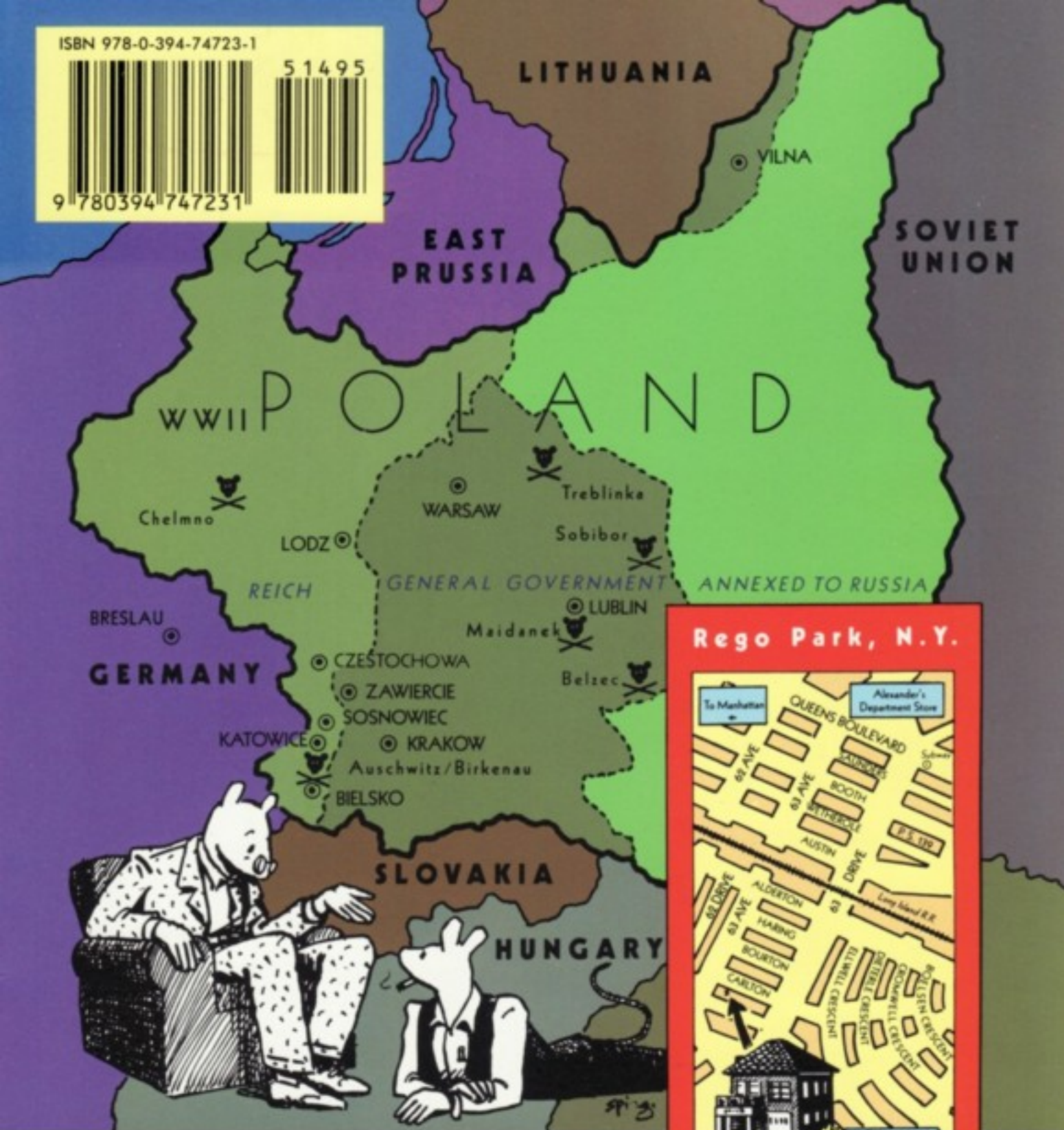
