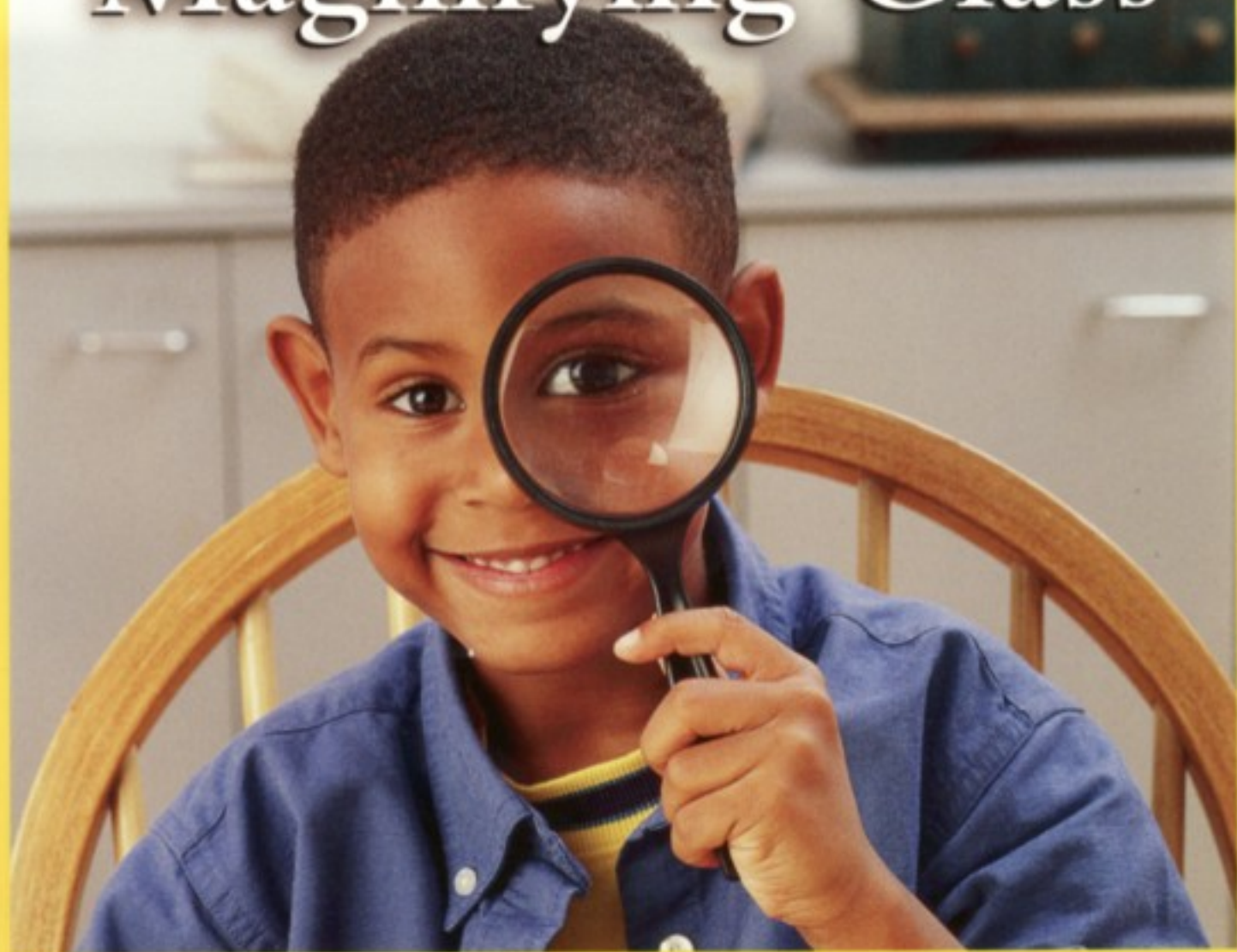

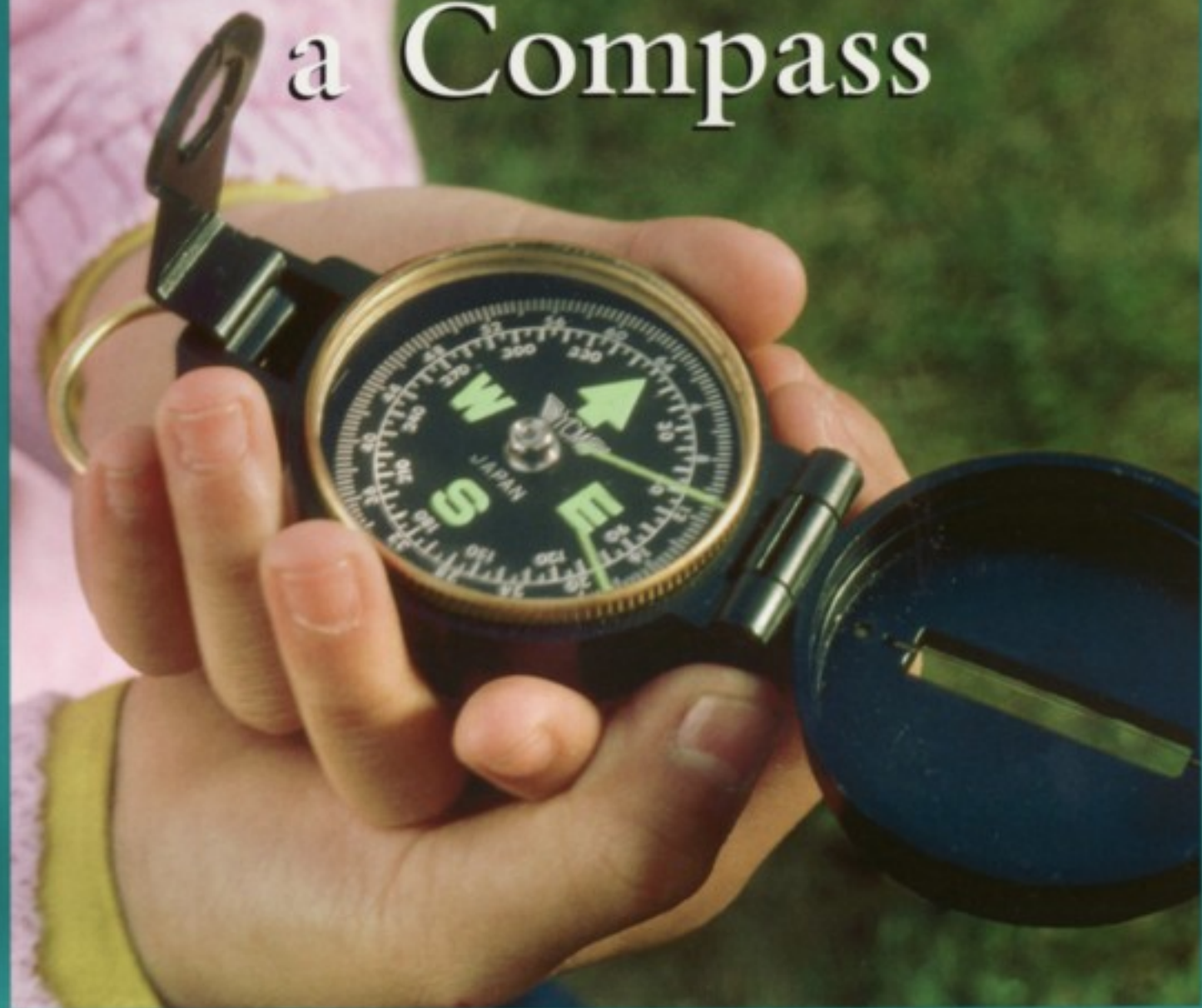
What can you see through

south, east, and west.

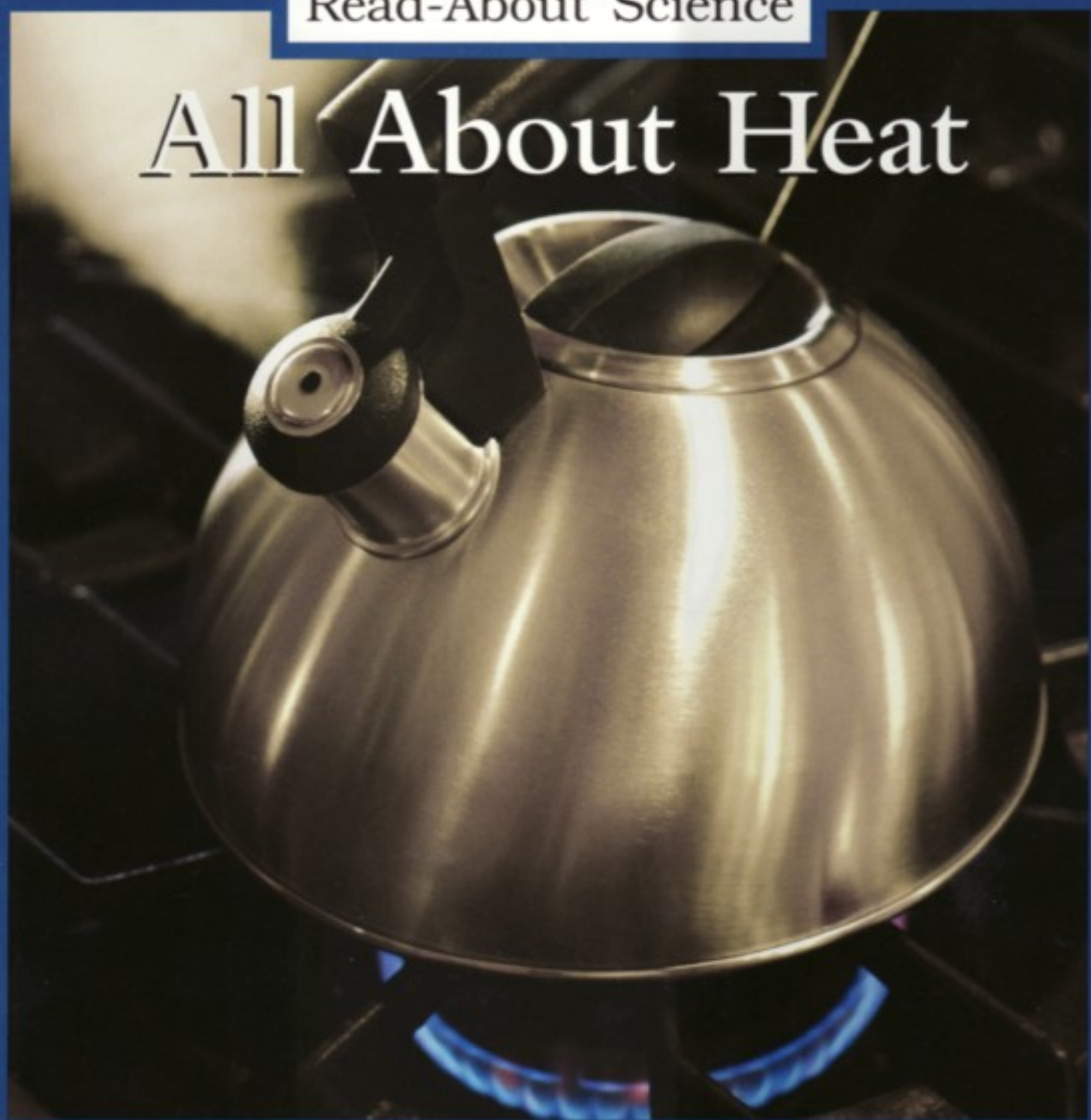
A compass looks sort of

on a clock.



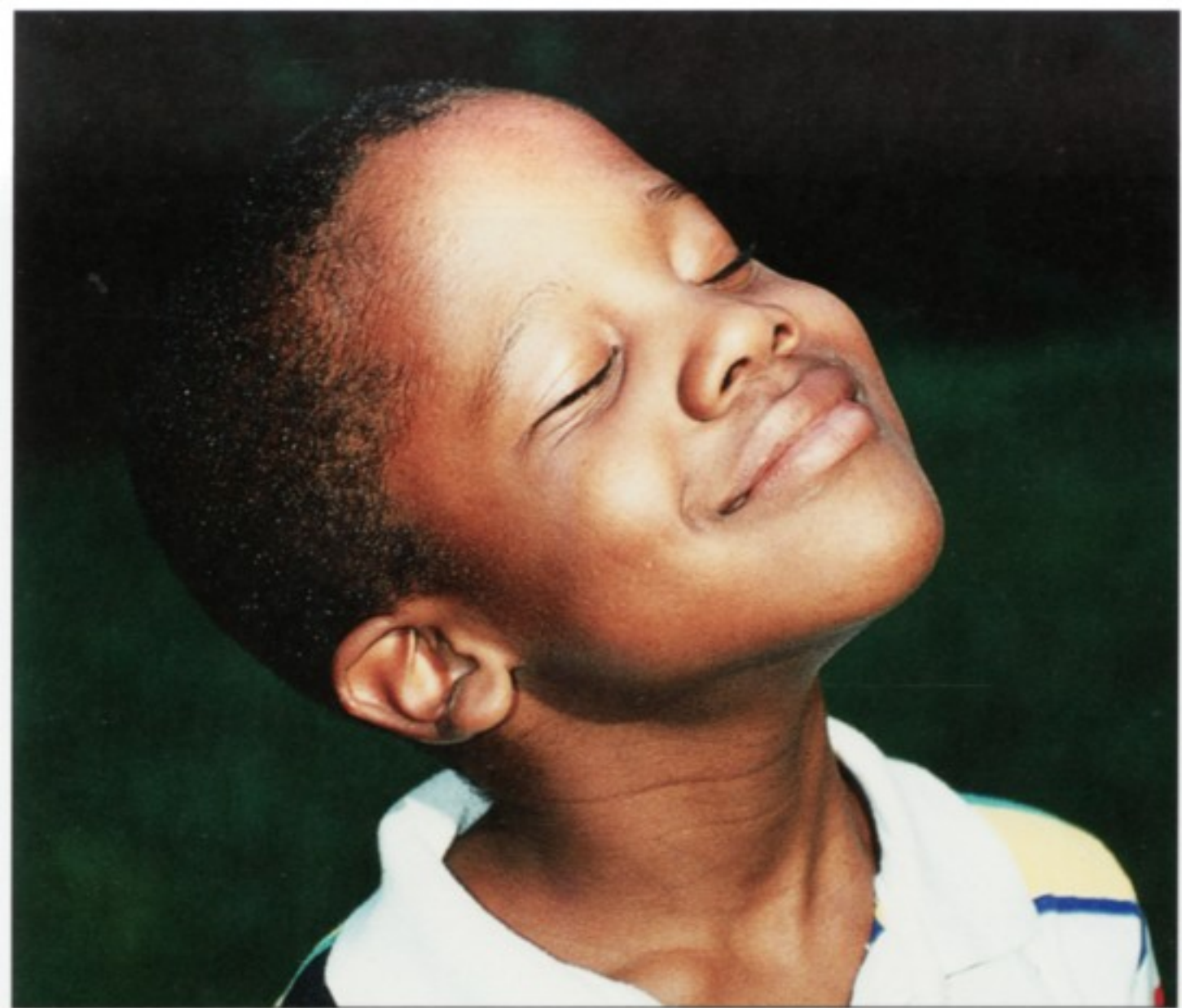

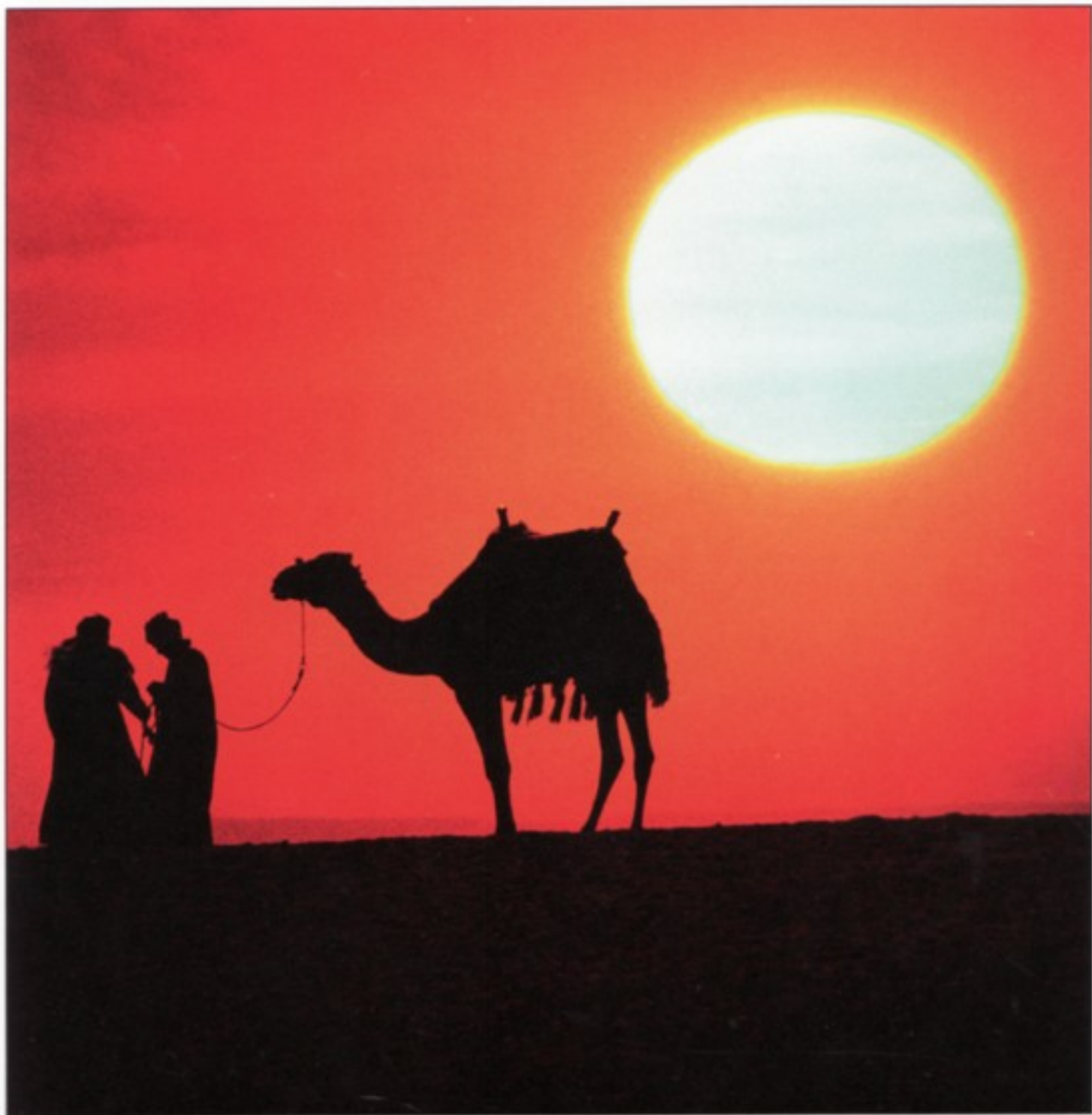
Close your eyes and lift

The sun gives off light.

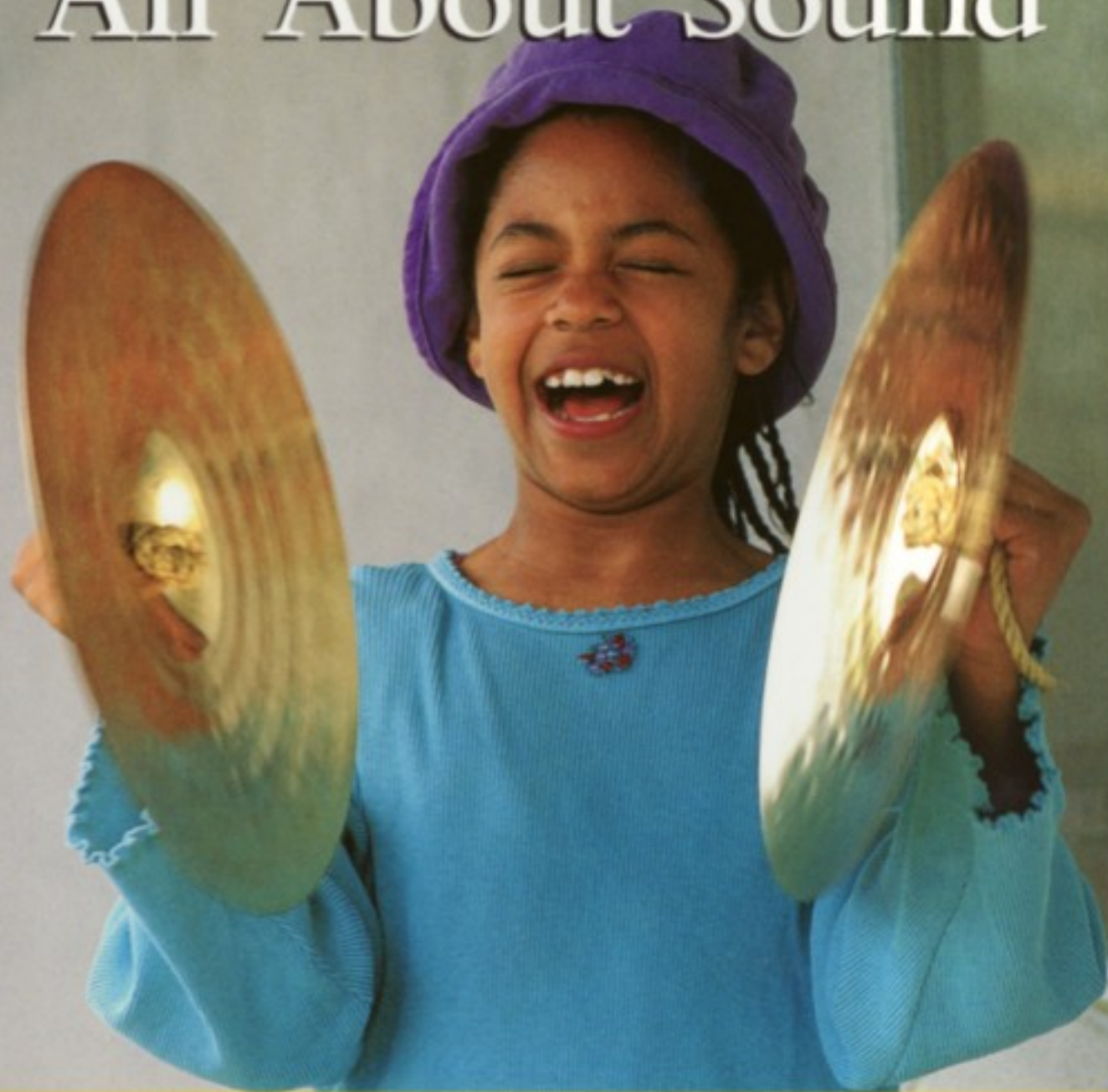
Fire gives off light.
