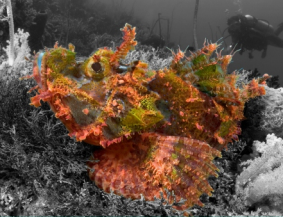


Hiding in the Ocean

Some ocean animals use **camouflage** to stay safe. They use their shape, color, or pattern to hide from other animals.
