If you were an adjective, you would work side by side with nouns. A noun names a person, place, or thing. As an adjective, you would be busy describing nouns.

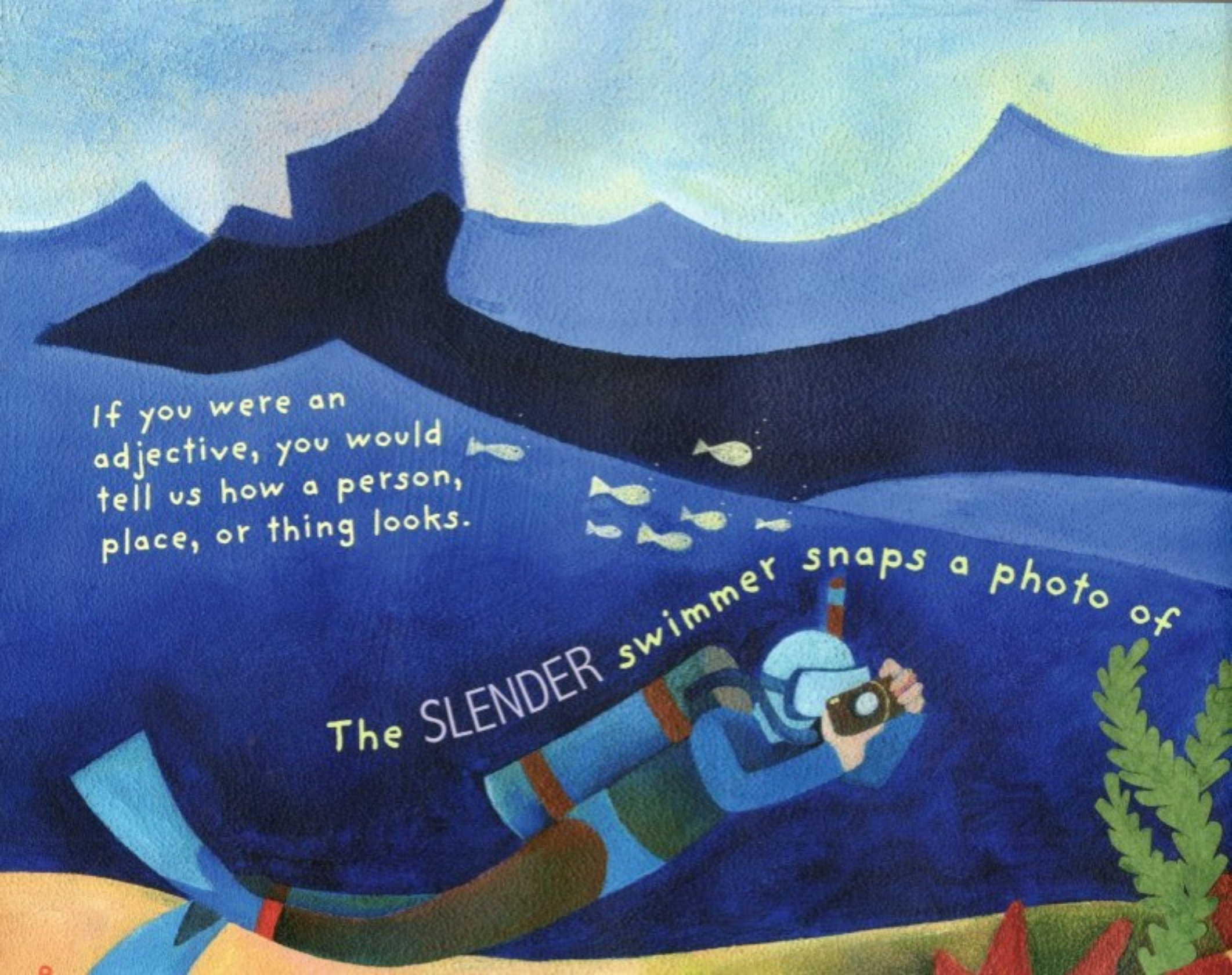


An elephant is a noun.

If you were an adjective, you would tell us about the elephant.

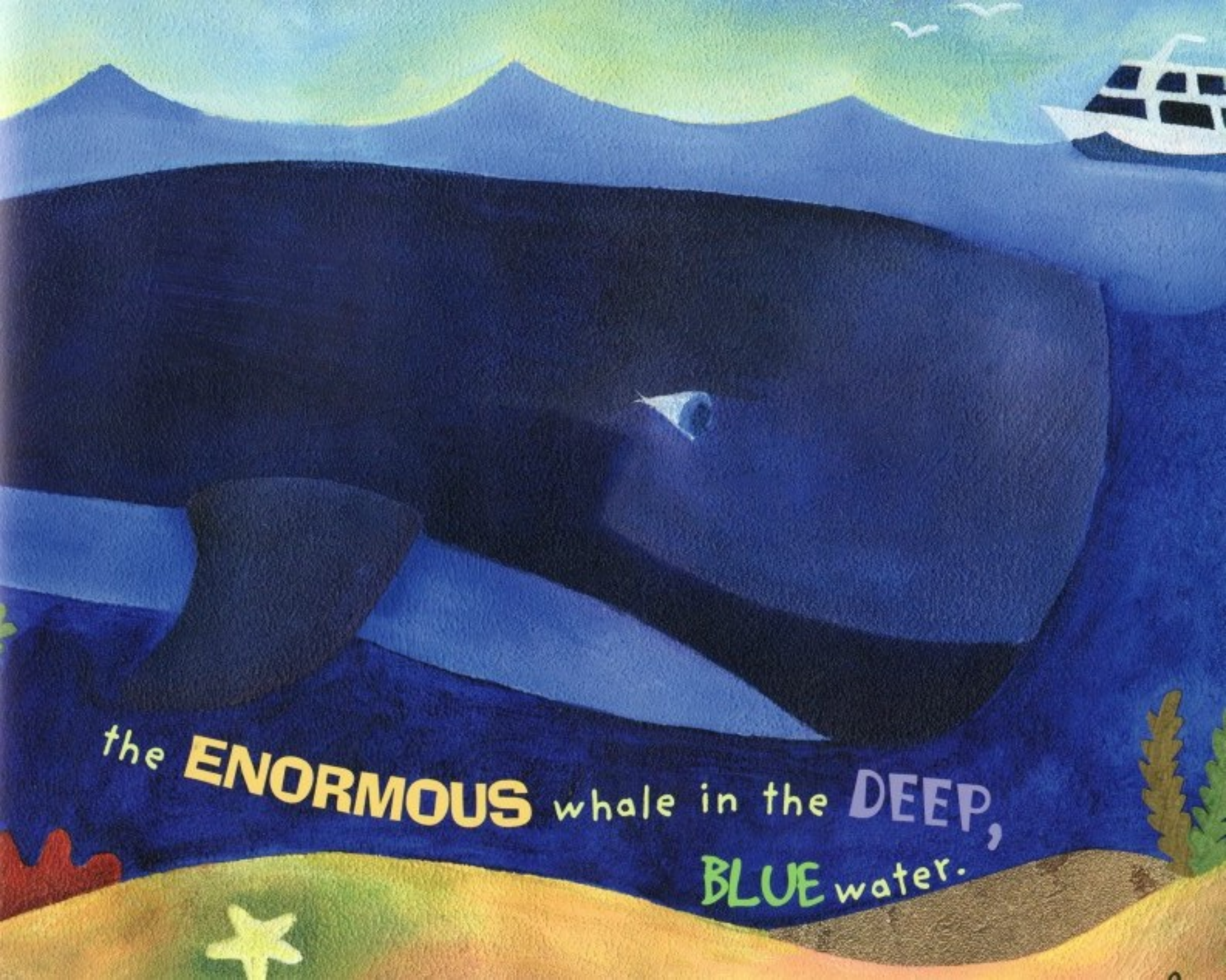


The **GRAY** elephant is **GIGANTIC** and **WET**. The **SPARKLING** water cools down the **HOT** elephant.

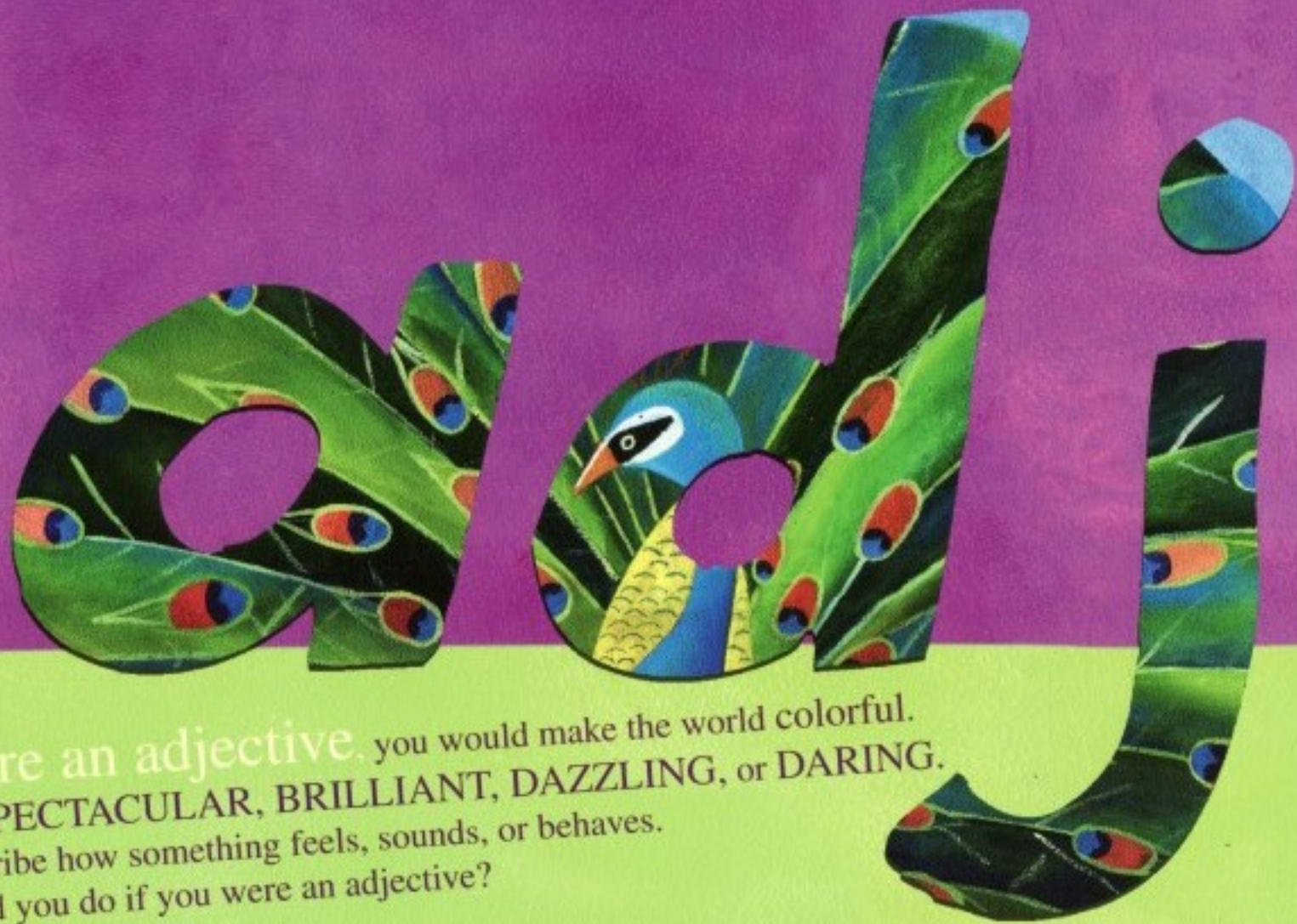
