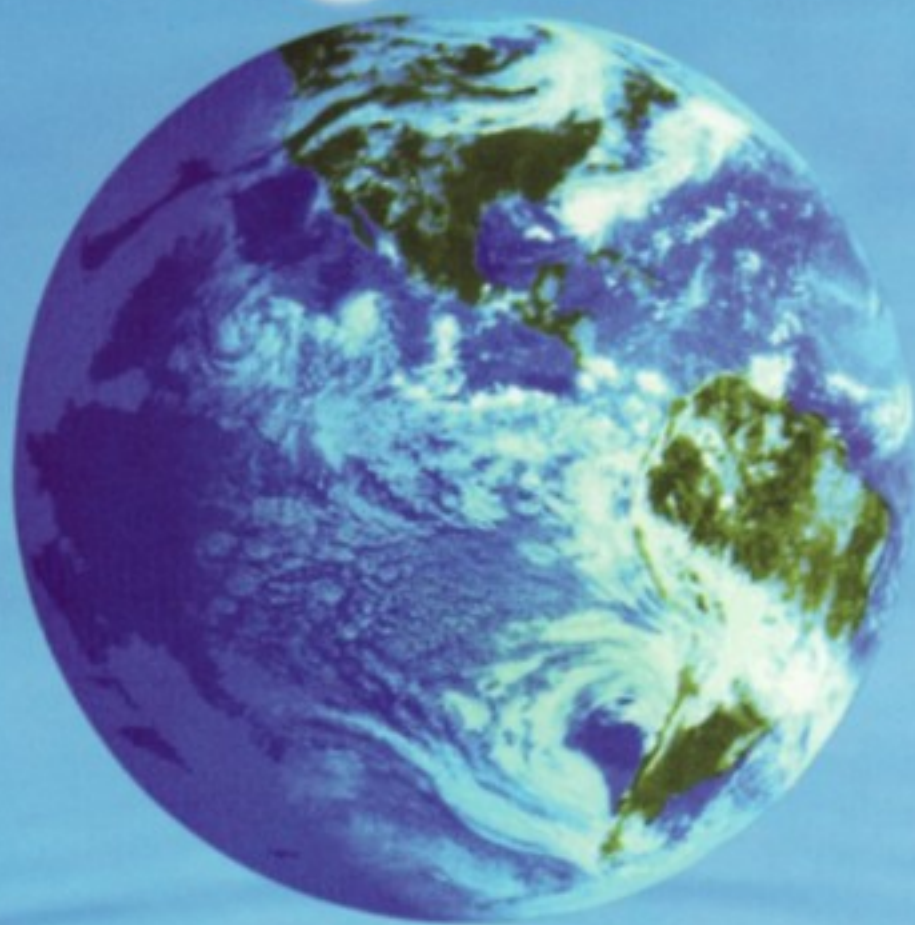


# Water Everywhere
