## LOOK ONCE

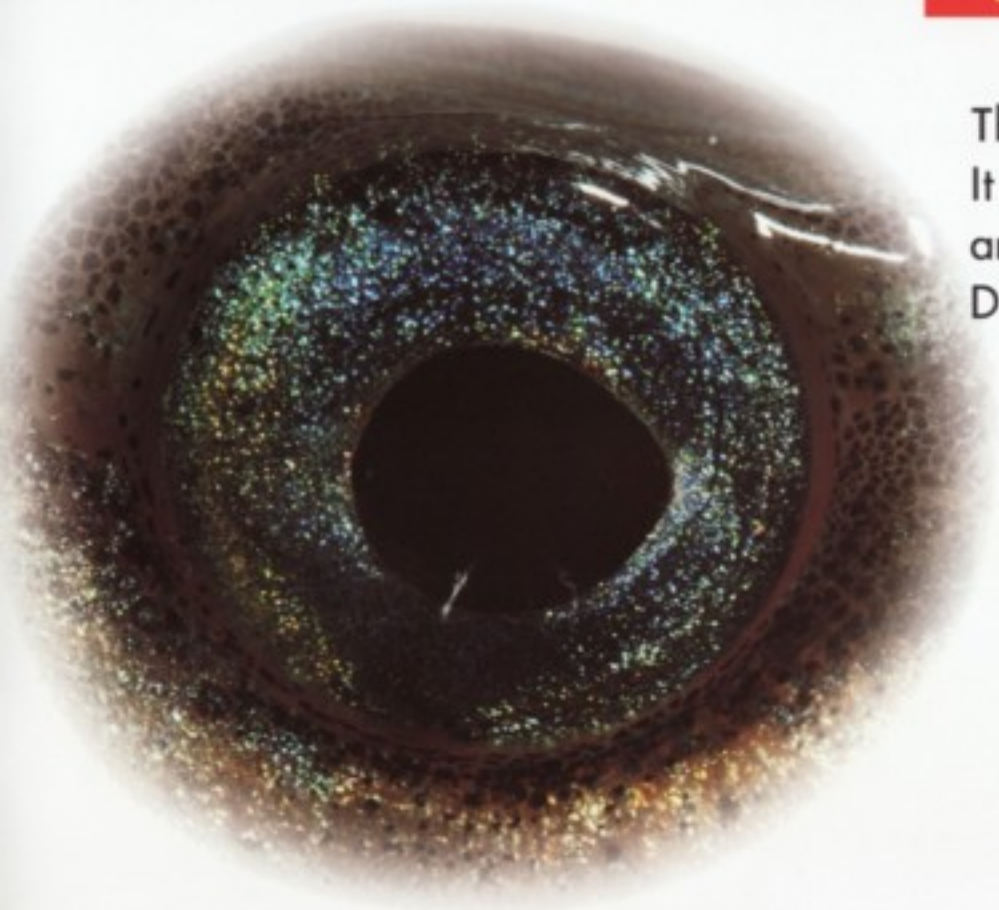
The owner of these eyes might be looking for a new shell to call home.
