“There is one thing you forgot.”



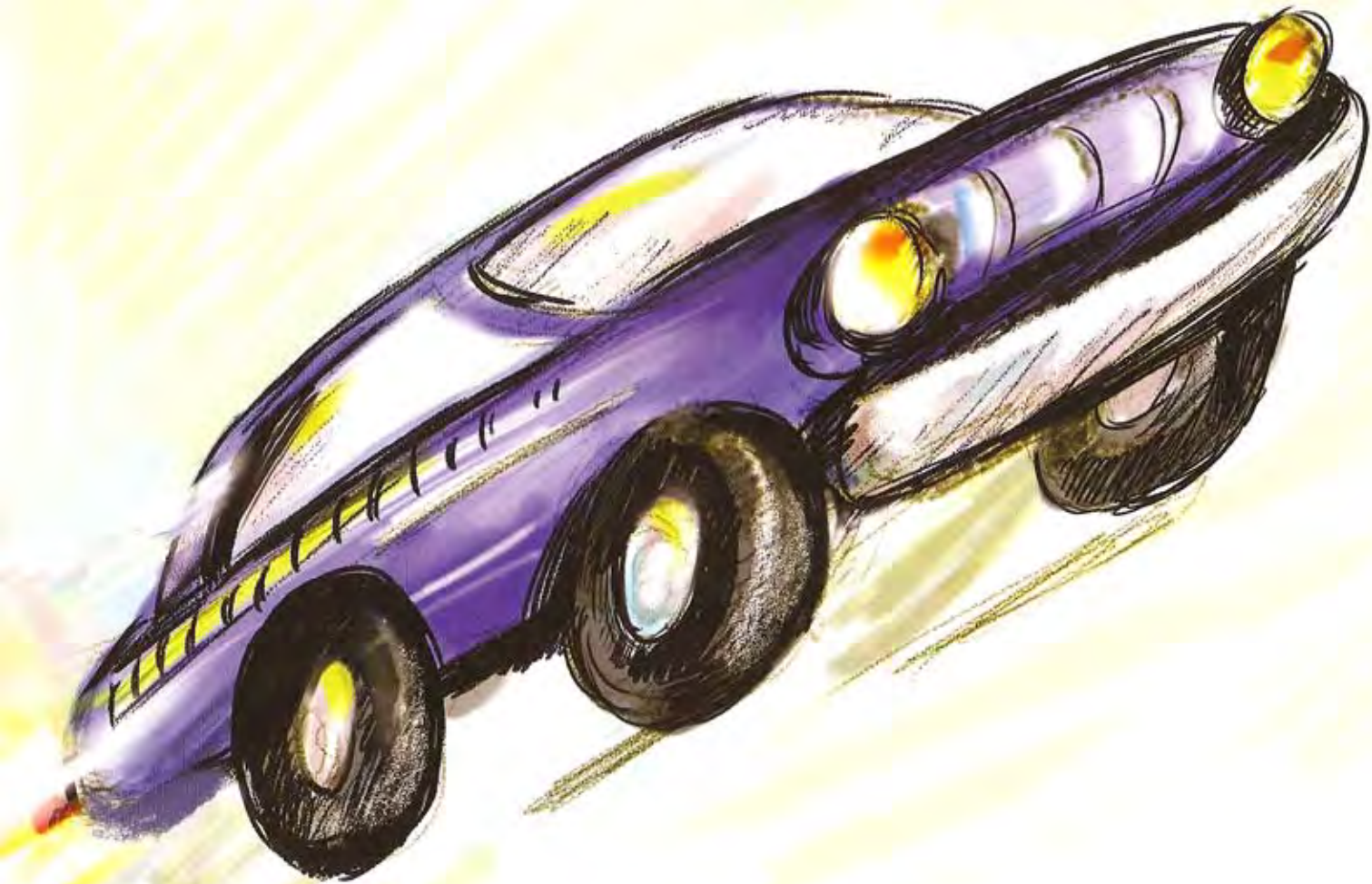
I forgot the card!
But that was OK.



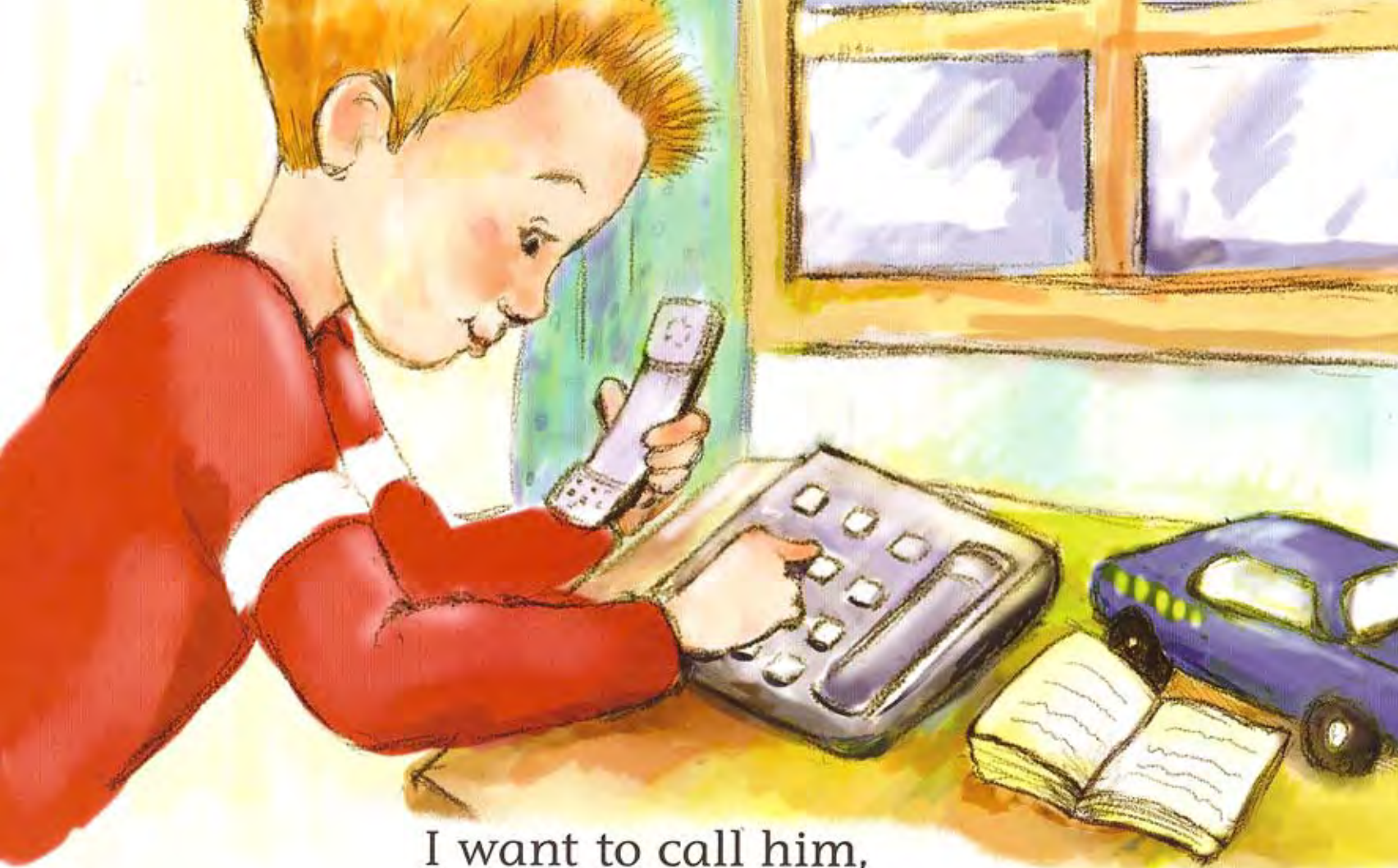
I took out my paints

so I pick up the phone.

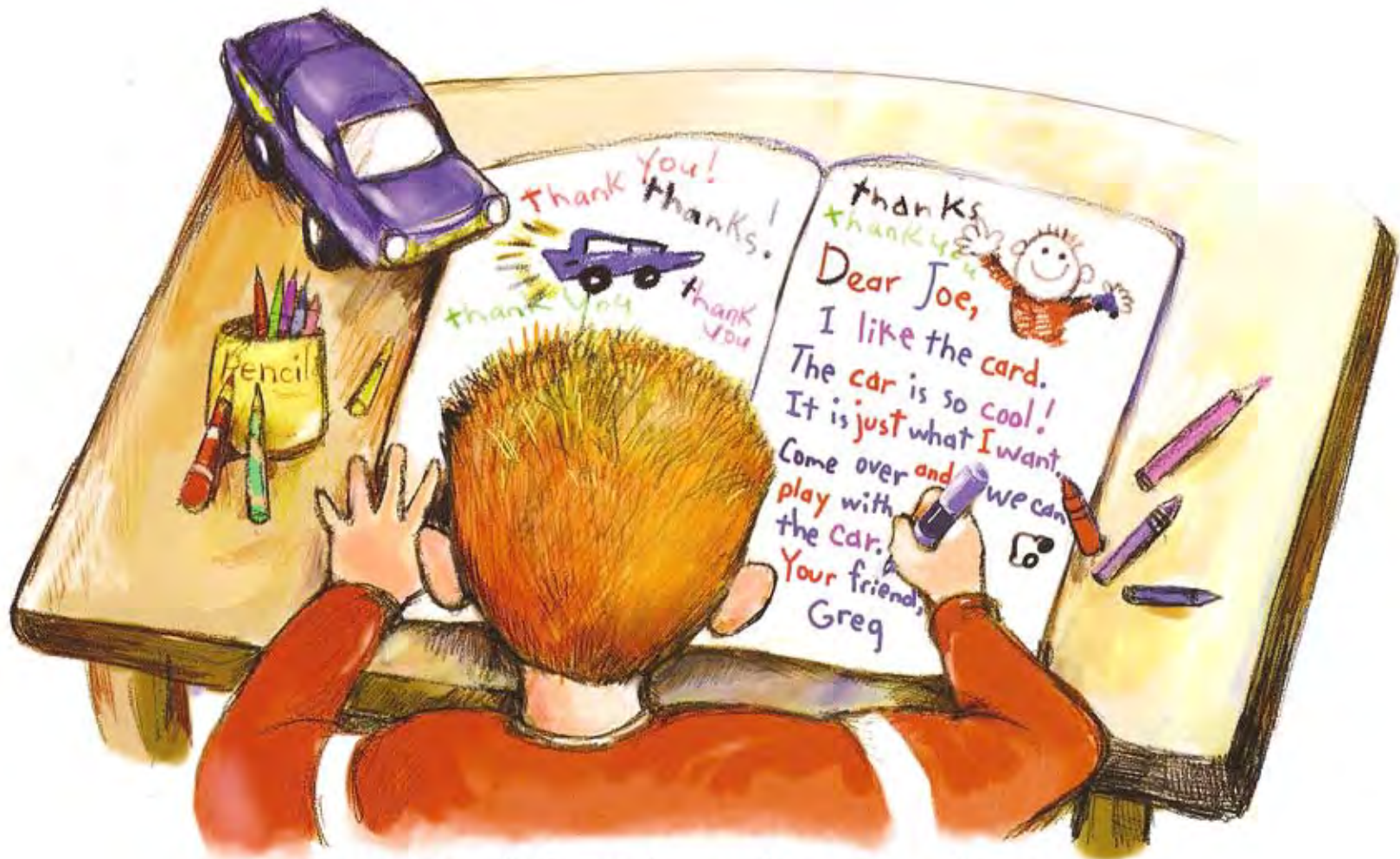
We are not
