

Spelling Tip Long o can be spelled o, oa, ow, and o-consonant-e. The symbol for long o is /ō/. Long u has two sounds. The /ū/ sound is spelled u and has a y sound at the beginning of the vowel. The /ü/ sound is spelled u, ue, ew, oo, ou, u-consonant-e, and ui-consonant-e. The difference between /ū/ and /ü/ is slight.
