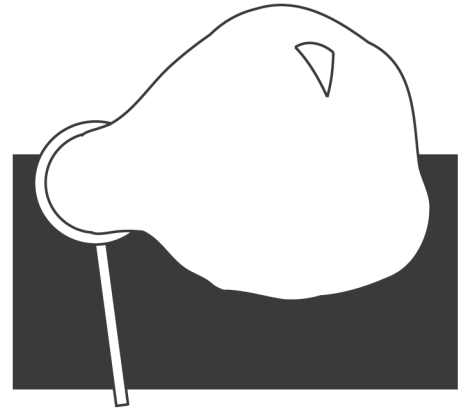

Alan McKay is the world champion. The first world champion was Sheldon Schafer. He got to write the rules for the rest of the world.

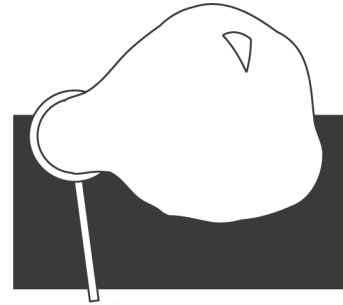
