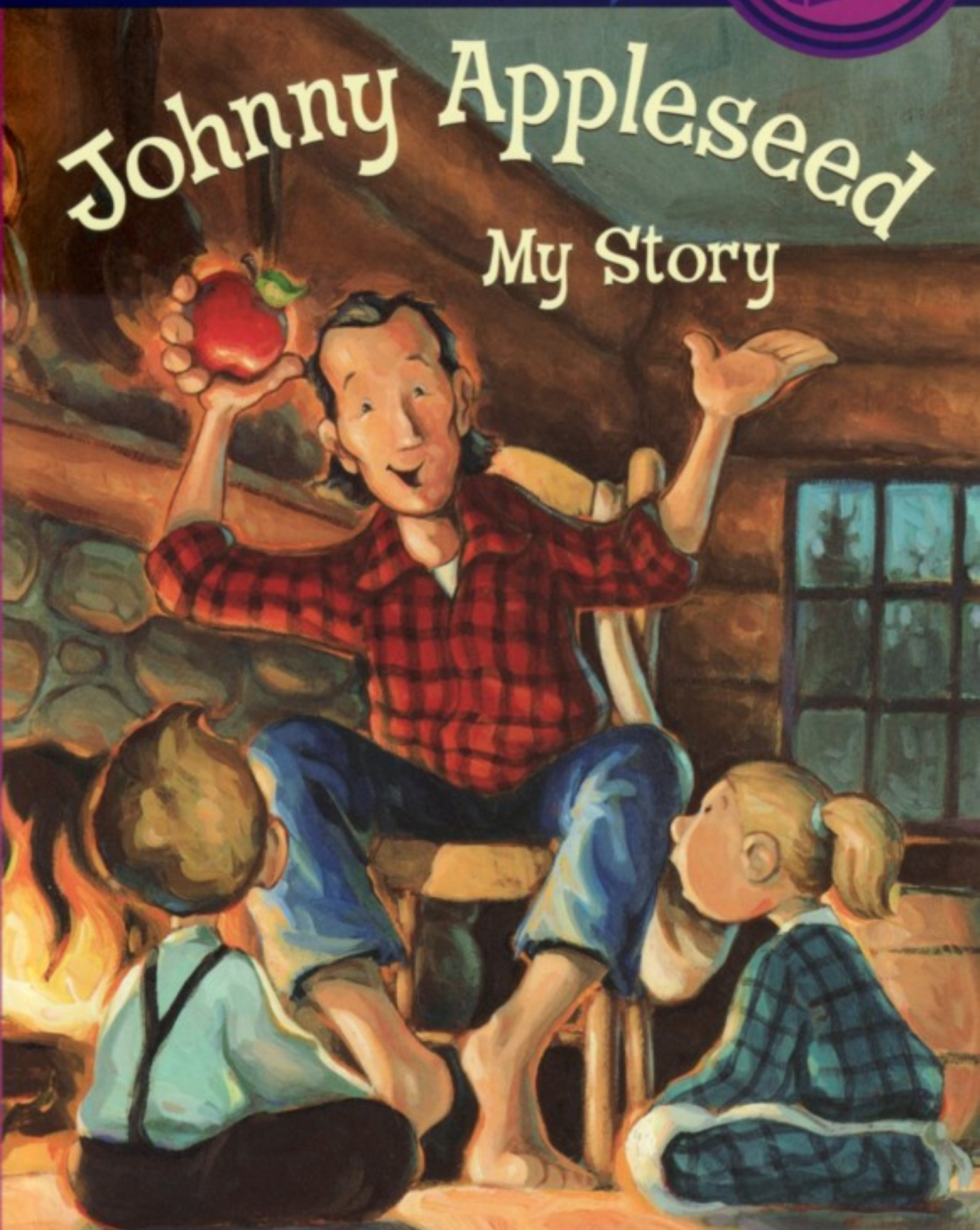

“Someone is coming!”


Beth yelled.
