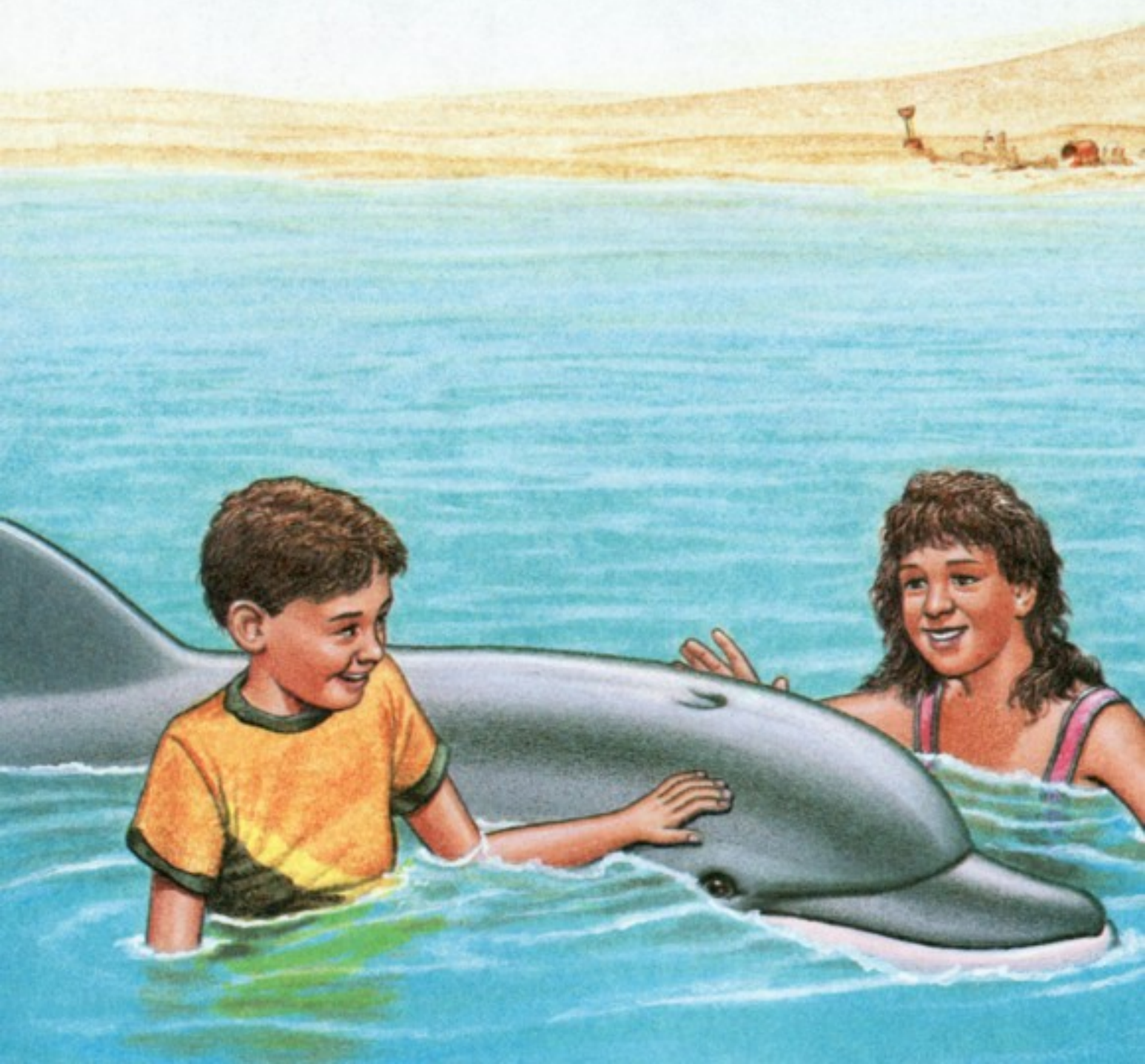

dolphins let people pet them.



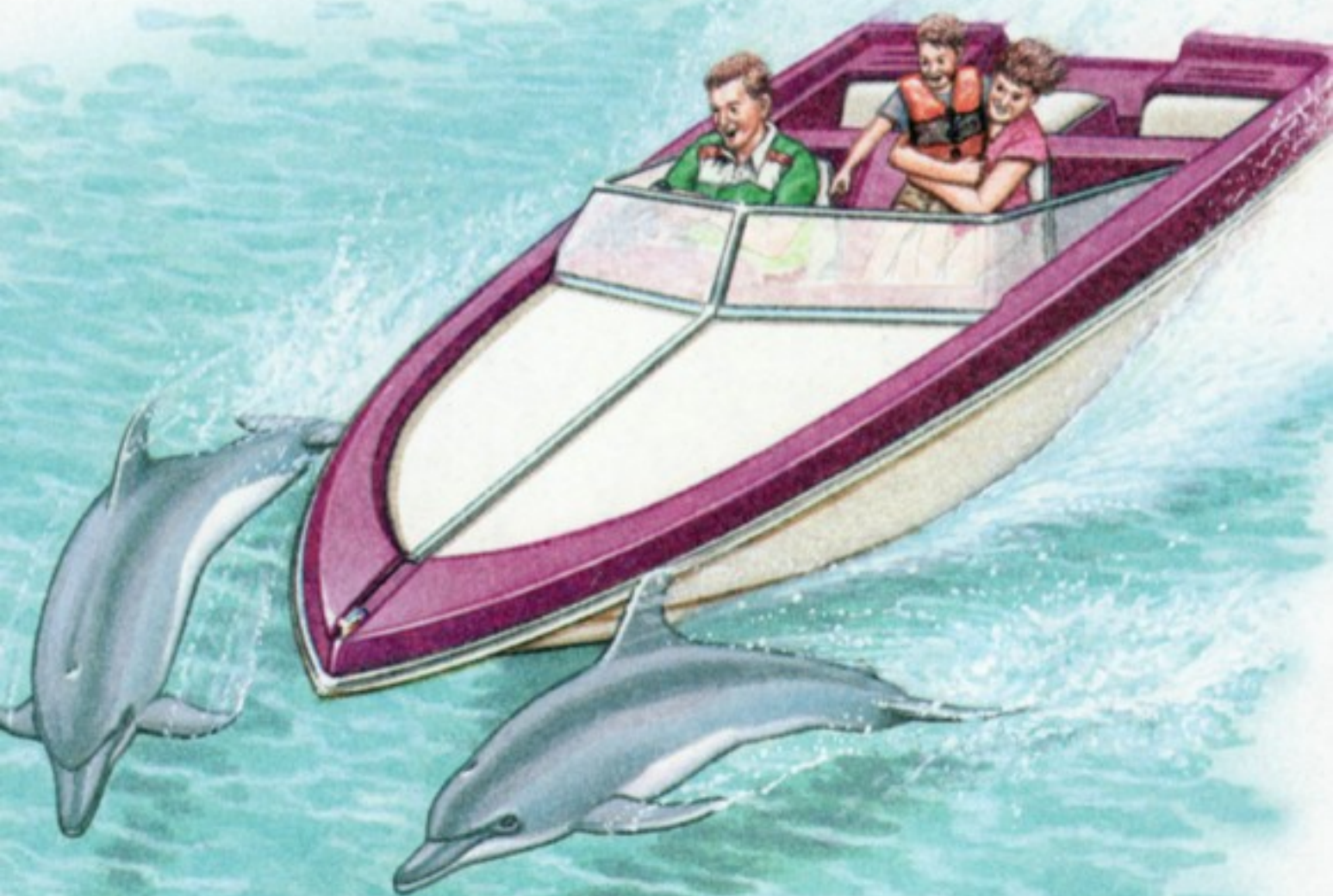
Dolphins are playful.
